The Hopi Tribe Economic Development Corporation is a Federally Chartered Section 17 Corporation, wholly owned by the Hopi Tribe. The HTEDC is established under federal charter provisions making it distinct and separate from the Hopi Tribe. A Board of seven directors governs the HTEDC. After an interview process, the Hopi Tribal Council appoints the Board members.

All Directors are required to meet the qualifications set forth in the HTEDC By-laws and must pass a mandatory background check.
