It is established under federal charter provisions, making it distinct and separate from the Hopi Tribe. HTEDC is governed by a Board of seven directors, who are appointed by the Hopi Tribal Council following an interview process.

All Directors must meet the qualifications outlined in the HTEDC By-laws and pass a mandatory background check. Submission of resume and cover letter are needed.
